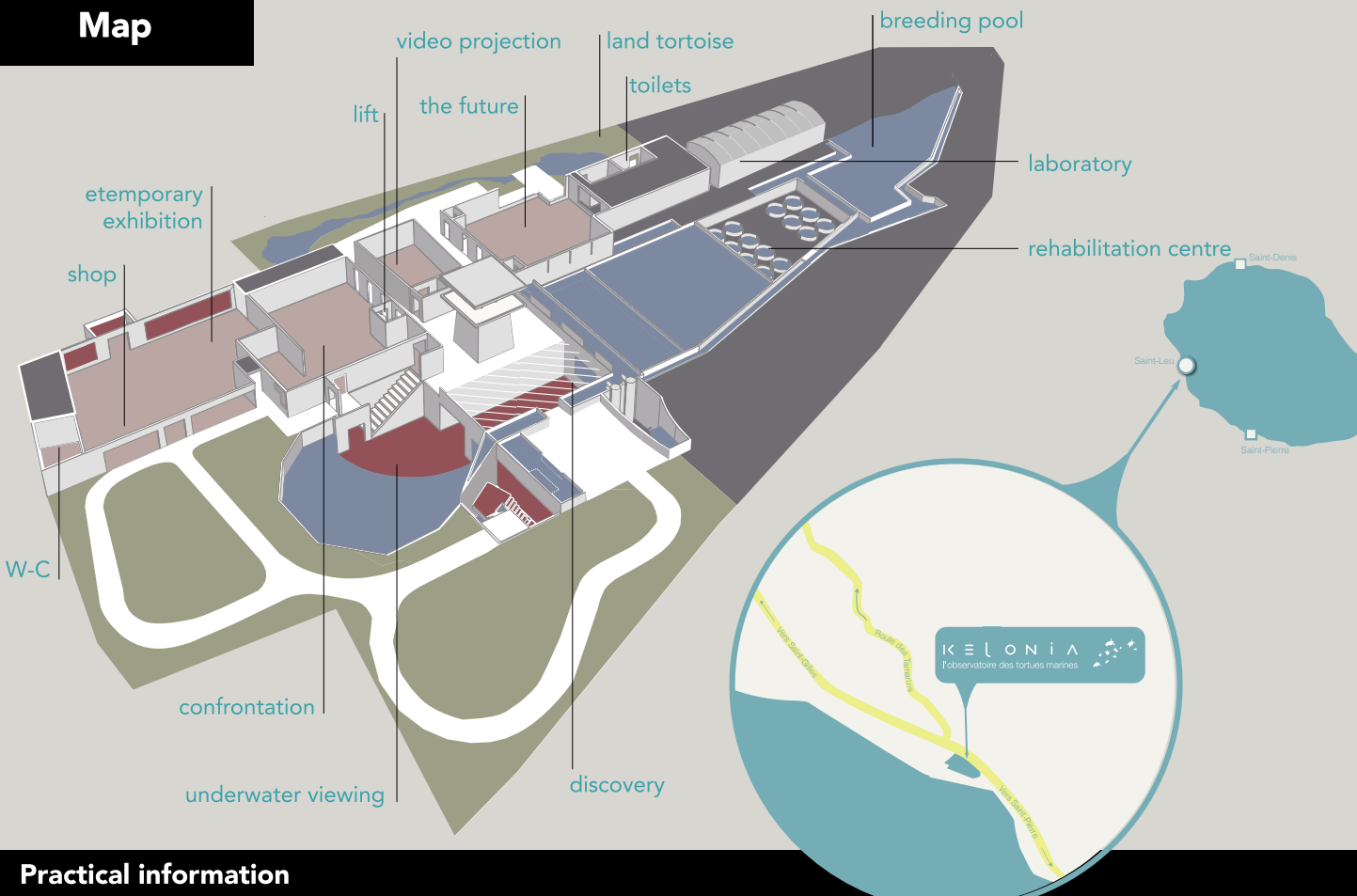

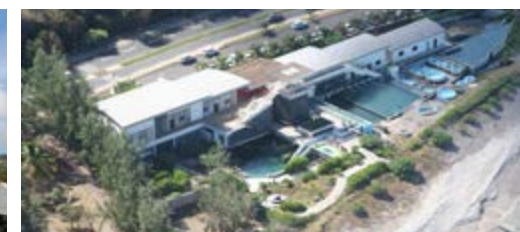

Dive into the universe of these marine reptiles. Discover their biological mysteries.



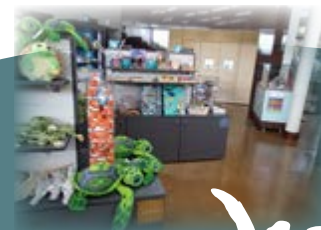
Confrontation
